CYSTIC FIBROSIS FUNDRAISER

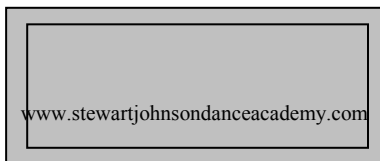
Once again the SJDA will be having a Spring Concert for Cystic Fibrosis on Saturday, June 5th at 7pm located at the Bordentown Middle School. All tickets are \$10 per person. When the Cystic



Fibrosis Foundation was established in 1955, most children did not live to attend elementary school. Today, the predicted median age of survival is more than 37 years, thanks—in large part—to the care provided through the national network of CF Foundation-accredited centers. The network provides expert cystic fibrosis care for people living with the disease. In fact, the National Institutes of Health has cited the CF care center network as a model of effective and efficient health care delivery for a chronic disease. The Foundation funds and accredits about 115 cystic fibrosis care centers nationwide. Most care centers have a pediatric and adult program or clinic. Some centers also include affiliate programs. All programs, however, are staffed by dedicated healthcare professionals who specialize in the treatment of cystic fibrosis.

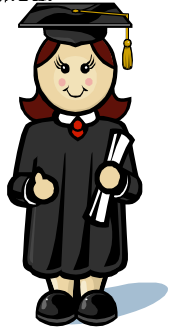
SUMMER & FALL CLASSES

ARE YOU READY FOR RECITAL???????

Here are a few tips for the new mothers that have joined our family of dance here at SJDA. Getting ready for your first dress rehearsal and recital can be exciting, but also scary.

- Make sure your child's name is in all his/her shoes
- Make sure that your costume is on a hanger so there is no wrinkles...if you have a tutu, hang up side down so the tutu will be fuller
- Check the costume book to make sure you have all the pieces to the costume, correct color of tights, shoes, etc.
- Check with teacher about hair style for that dance.
- Make up for dress rehearsals and recitals is recommended.
- No jewelry is to be worn while dancing, except if part of the costume.
- Remember to bring your Dress Rehearsal "Mothers Pass" and Recital Tickets.
